

MGHPCC SC video guide

To create your video, we recommend using the record function while presenting using Zoom. Your video will be uploaded to the MGHPCC Vimeo channel, from where it will be embedded on its own page on the MGHPCC's SC23 website.

The goal of these videos is to illustrate the rich diversity of research the MGHPCC helps facilitate.

Your video will introduce viewers to your work - what you do, and why it matters - and to share with them how high-performance computing systems at the MGHPCC help enable it.

Keep it short - 2 minutes is actually quite long for a quick explainer video so feel free to go under!

Keep it simple - assume an educated audience, but not necessarily one with domain knowledge or expertise. If you must use technical terms, take a moment to explain.

Keep it eye-catching - including imagery and animations can help create a more engaging presentation. Remember your audience will likely be unfamiliar with what they are looking at so, where appropriate, be sure to explain.
